Ways to Give

REAL ESTATE

Real Estate such as personal residences, farms, vacation homes, commercial and rental property is often the subject of gifts. Like gifts of appreciated securities, gifts of real estate can be attractive because of the double tax benefit—an immediate charitable contribution and the avoidance of capital gains tax.

GIFTS-IN-KIND

Gifts-in-Kind are goods and services whose worth cannot necessarily be counted in dollars, but provide an added benefit to the organization. This includes supporting our fleet of vans with oil, gas and maintenance. We are one of the first organizations in the country to provide treatment transportation to our customers.

PLEDGES

Pledges may spread gift payments over a period of years. Many of The LCADA Way supporters have made multi-year pledges to the capital campaign and other avenues of support.

LIFE INSURANCE

You may purchase a new Life Insurance policy or simply donate a policy that you already hold but no longer need. Designating The LCADA Way as the owner and beneficiary of the policy can provide valuable tax benefits.

CASH

Cash is the simplest and most direct way to contribute to The LCADA Way. You may designate your gift for a specific purpose or you may choose to leave your gift undesignated to benefit the organization's area of greatest need. Cash gifts generally provide an immediate charitable income tax deduction for the amount of the gift.


